Sub:- Admissions for the academic year 2019-20 in existing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and PG Course in 06 subjects namely Organon of Medicine, Pharmacy, Materia Medica, Practice of Medicine, Repertory and Paediatrics with 06 seats each at Naiminath Homoeopathic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Village Nawalpur, Tehsil Etmadpur, Agra- Reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder. In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has conducted inspection of **Naiminath Homoeopathic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Village Nawalpur, Tehsil Etmadpur, Agra on 14.05.2019 and furnished recommendation as under:-**

"Recommended for allowing admissions in I-BHMS Course for the session 2019-20 with the intake capacity of 100 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course and MD(Hom) course in Organon with 03 seats and in Pharmacy, Materia medica, Practice of medicine, Repertory and Paediatrics, with 04 seats in each..."

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Naiminath Homoeopathic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Village Nawalpur, Tehsil Etmadpur, Agra for continuing admissions in I-BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and PG Course in 06 subjects namely Organon of Medicine, Pharmacy, Materia Medica, Practice of Medicine, Repertory and Paediatrics with 06 seats each for the Academic Year 2019-20.

3. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate seats and 15% of post graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats and 36 seats of MD (Hom) course shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned State Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission to the college will stand withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

5. The College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit duly notarized within one month from date of issue of this permission letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

6. Further, the College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st December, 2019 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.

7. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31st December, 2019 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2020-21 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
