**Sub: Permission matter of Naiminath Homoeopathic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Village Nawalpur, Tehsil Etmadpur, Agra (UP) for 100 seats in Undergraduate (BHMS) course and Postgraduate [MD(Hom)] Course with 36 seats in 06 subjects namely Organon of Medicine (06), Repertory (06), Materia Medica (06), Practice of Medicine (06), Pharmacy (06), Pediatrics (06) for academic session 2022-23 – reg.**

Sir,

As per provision of NCH Act, 2020 Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MA&RBH) has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission for student intake to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy.

2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has received online application (Part-1) seeking permission for student intake in under graduate course (BHMS) with intake capacity of 100 seats in Undergraduate (BHMS) course and Postgraduate [MD(Hom)] Course with 36 seats in 06 subjects namely Organon of Medicine (06), Repertory (06), Materia Medica (06), Practice of Medicine (06), Pharmacy (06), Pediatrics (06) for academic session 2022-23. Accordingly, it is to inform you that Part-1 proforma and all the relevant documents submitted by your college were examined as per the existing regulations.

3. On scrutiny and careful consideration of the documents and further observations of the Board, the shortfalls were observed to be addressed for granting permission for student intake in UG (BHMS) and PG [MD(Hom)] course for the academic year 2022-23. Accordingly:

#### A. Teaching Faculty:

- Documents of Dr. Vivek Vashishtha, Guest Reader in Pathology 02 years teaching experience as a Lecturer is not submitted.
- 03 Guest Faculties, Dr. Suman Jain, Professor, Dept. of Gynecology & Obstetrics, Dr. Neeraj Verma, Professor, Dept. of Practice of Medicine, Dr. Prashant Gupta, Professor, Dept. of Surgery are posted as Modern Medicine Consultants also which is not acceptable as per regulation.
- Attendance and acquaintance of Hospital staff shall be submitted for verification.

4. After considering the provisions of NCH Act, 2020 permission of the **Medical Assessment and Rating Board for continuing student intake of 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course and 36 seats in 06 subjects namely Organon of Medicine (06), Repertory (06), Materia Medica (06), Practice of Medicine (06), Pharmacy (06), Pediatrics (06) for academic session 2022-23.** The College Principal is directed to fulfill all deficiencies within a period of 3 months and an undertaking shall be submitted in this regard within 01 week from the Controlling Authority of the College.

5. All admissions in Under Graduate (BHMS) course shall be through 'National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET)' only. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not


be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy as per rules and the penalty as decided will be imposed only.

6. All admissions in Under Graduate (BHMS) course shall be through 'National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET)' and all admissions in Post Graduate course shall be through 'All India Ayush Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIAPGET)' only. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy as per rules and the penalty as decided will be imposed.

7. The counselling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling Authority of State/ UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counselling Authority of that State / UT. 100% Under Graduate & Post Graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity shall be treated as all India quota for Deemed University as they are All India in nature. The Counselling of seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government.

8. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under. The category wise list of students admitted may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed.


